It was agreed to keep subscriptions at the same level.

They had been enjoyable and interesting even when compared to the three professional ones we had. The post Christmas party with its competitions was once again very enjoyable. Mary was thanked for co-ordinating all those who made the evening a real success.

The 'new' raffle held at each meeting with two usable prizes proved a good change.

Jan and Mike were thanked for handling the net coverage and Woody's news sheet.

John hoped to find a third professional demonstrator to fill the programme. The pole lathe team had moved but he still hoped he might locate them again and get a demo from them. He asked if anyone had contacts either for the pole team or just for a good demo by other club members.
